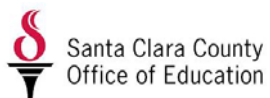




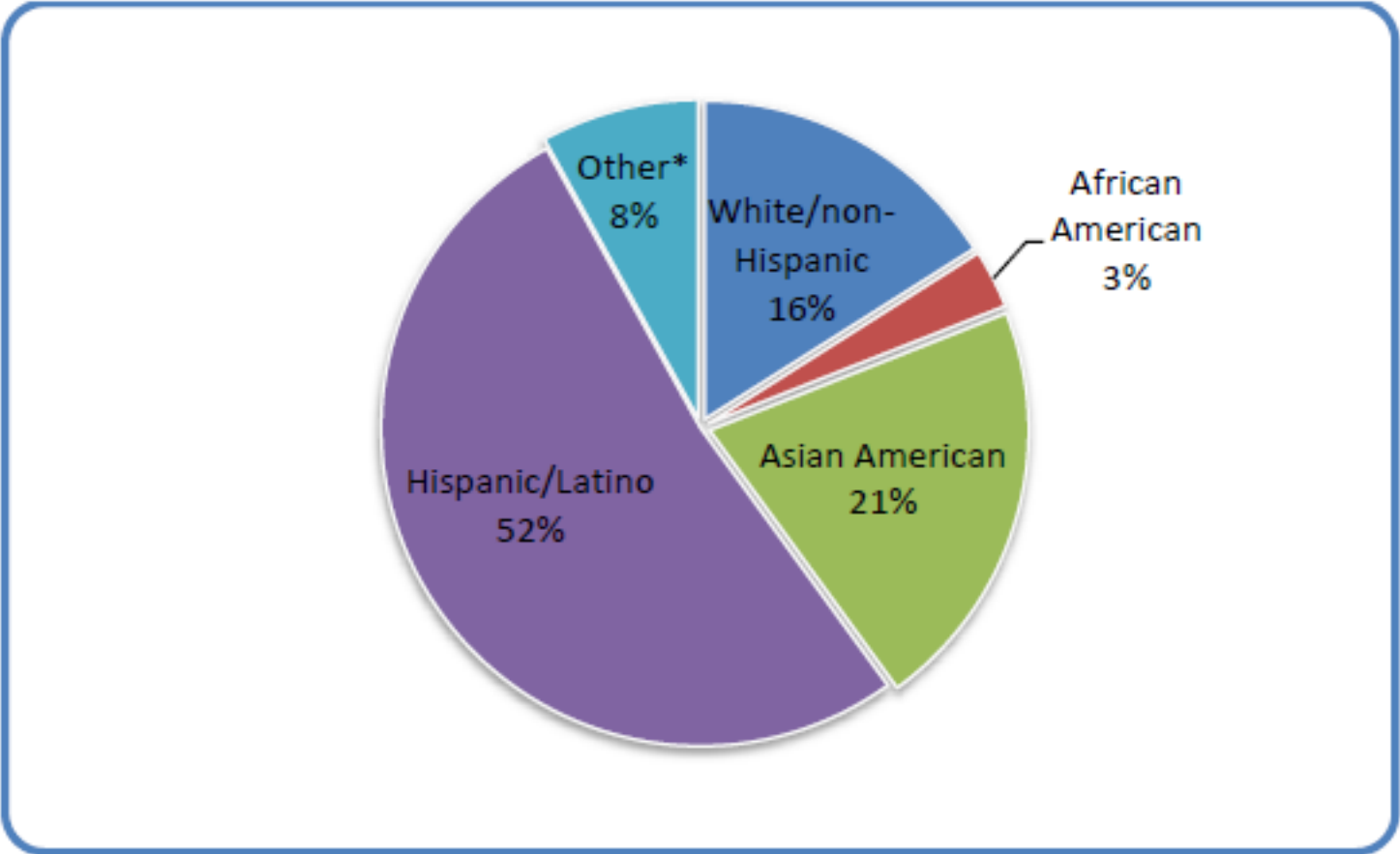

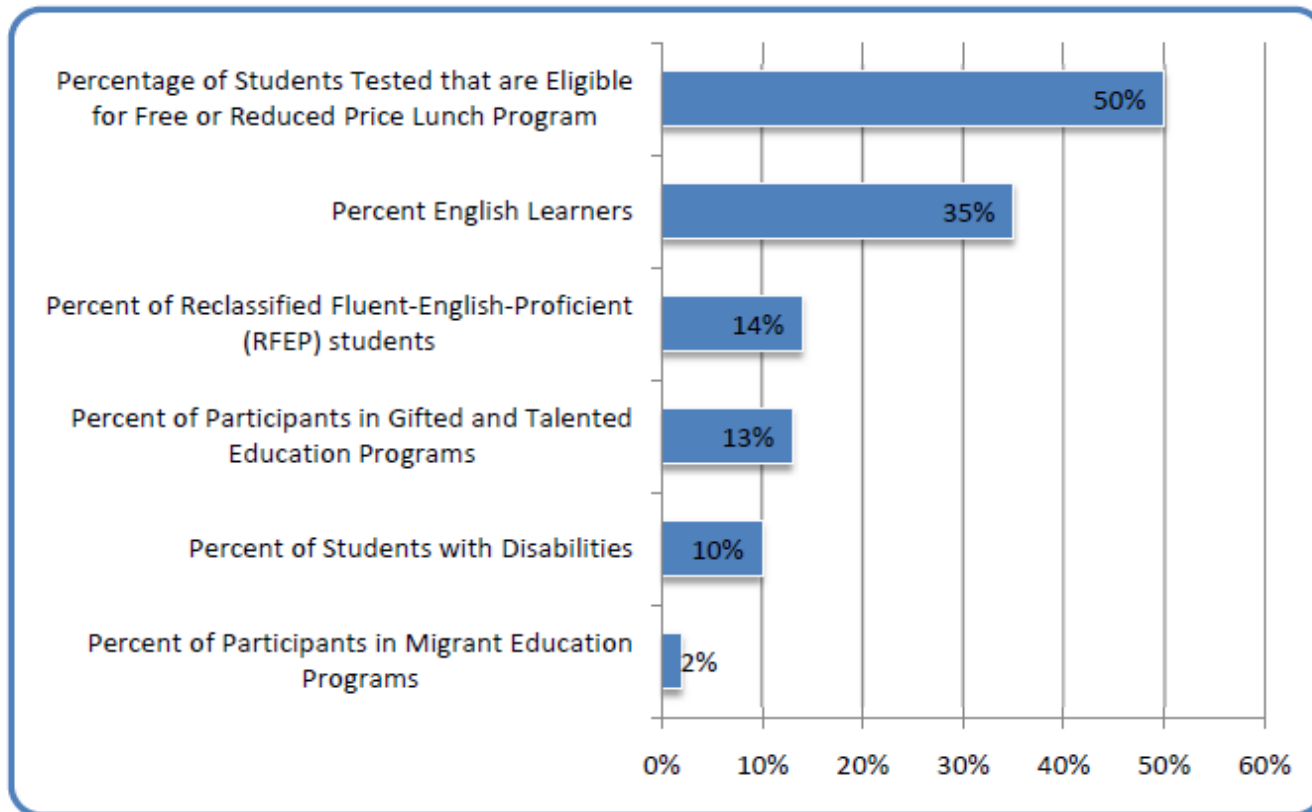
San Jose in Context: Demographics

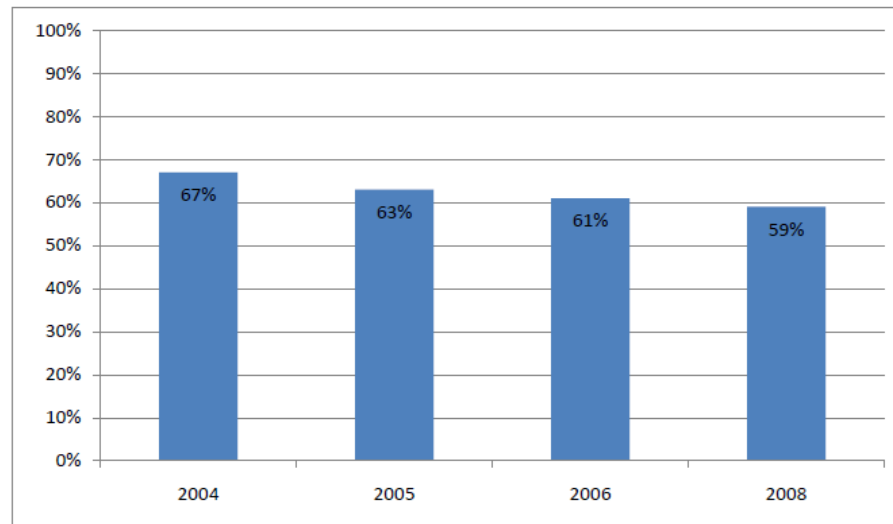
Arising from the disparity in academic achievement between lower performing Hispanic/ Latino and African American students and their higher-performing Asian and White/non-Hispanic peers, the **San José 2020** (SJ2020) initiative seeks to eliminate the racial/ethnic achievement gap by 2020 through collaborative efforts from the City of San Jose, the Santa Clara County Office of Education, school districts, charter schools, colleges, and business and nonprofit community agencies.



School Readiness

Following a recent survey asking teachers to rate student readiness levels in San Jose, only 59 % of kindergarteners were categorized as performing at or above teachers' expected proficiency levels.
