


Subject: Perfect Storm Revisited – San Jose Sanctuary Policies, Porous U.S.- Mexico Border, Ebola Virus Disease (EVD), Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS) and President Obama’s War with ISIS Announcement

Factor 1: Porous U.S.-Mexico border offers entry point for ISIS. Fox News reports “The union representing America’s immigration caseworkers warned Thursday of the “real and serious threat” that Islamic State terrorists could gain entry to the United States, either by slipping through the southern U.S. border or exploiting “loose and lax” visa policies.”

Factor 3: San Jose allows illegal immigrants to reside in the city without harassment. Police officers cannot ask immigration status of folks they stop. San Jose has tens of thousands of illegal immigrants living in the shadows, which is a perfect location for ISIS fighters to blend into the neighborhoods.

Factor 4: Ebola Virus Disease (EVD)
