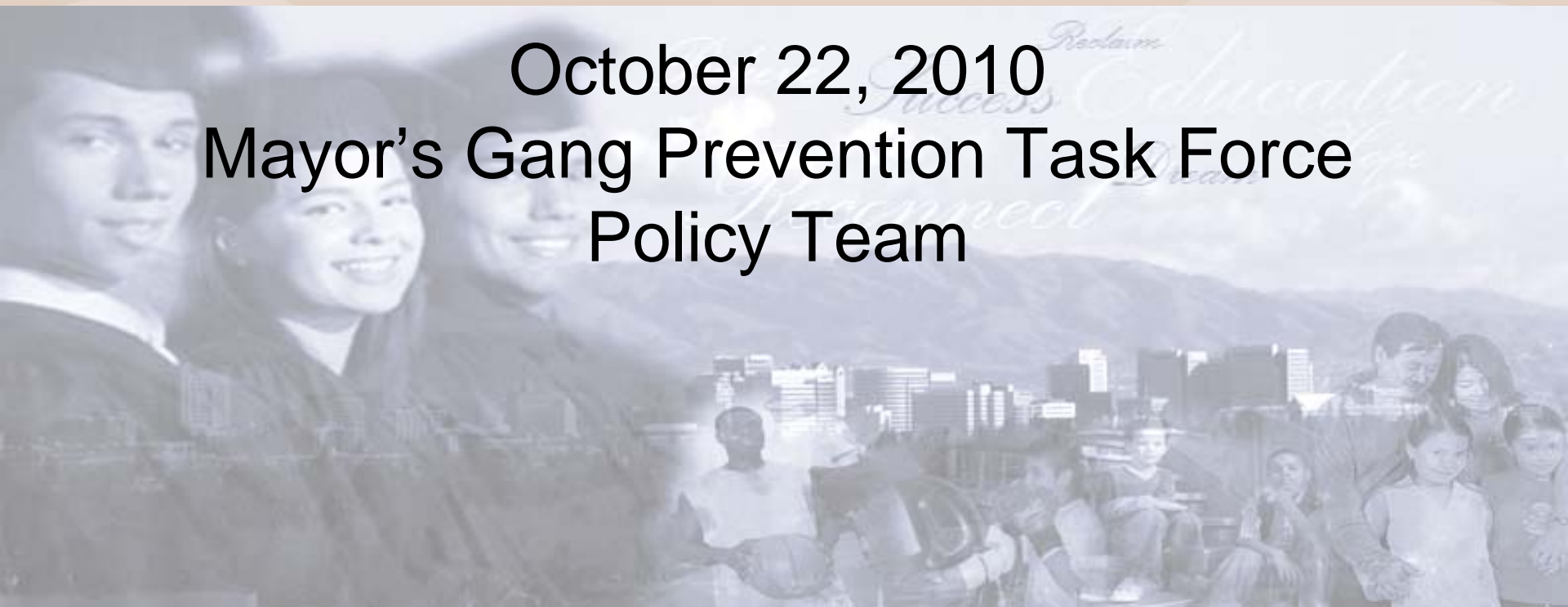

Safe Summer Grant Initiative

Purpose: To provide a safe and fun summer for San José youth.



RFP Highlights

- First City program to use WebGrants
- \$325,000 Funding
 - \$250,000: Mayor & Council
 - \$75,000: District Attorney's Office
- 85 applications were received requesting a total of \$1,121,776
- 30 applications were funded for a total of \$282,221
- The remaining funds were used to provide City program slots in summer camps, baseball clinics, etc.

Services Provided

- Educational and Creative Programs: including film making, fashion, painting, cooking and academic enrichment
- Sports Participation and Instruction: including baseball, tennis, bowling, trampoline, dance, personal and social development
- Field Trips: to museums, college campuses, beaches, camping, fishing, baseball games, go carts, paintball, white water rafting, etc...
- Special Events: community socials, block parties, National Night Out, BBQs, pizza parties, games, craft projects, etc...
