PLANNING COMMISSION

One (1) Seat with a Term Ending June 30, 2022

The Planning Commission is established in accordance with the City Charter (Section 1000). The members are residents of the City of San José appointed by the City Council. The Planning Commission has the responsibility of making recommendations to the City Council on:

- Adoption or amendment of the General Plan and specific and redevelopment plans for the future physical development of the City;
- Adoption or amendment of land use and redevelopment regulations, including zoning and subdivision;
- Adoption of the Capital Improvement Program; and
- Other duties as provided by the City Council.

The Planning Commission also:

- Acts as an appellate body on certain Planning Director decisions.
- Certifies Environmental Impact Reports

Planning Commission meets the second and fourth Wednesdays each month at 6:30 P.M., City Hall, Council Chambers.

Applicants who are selected to interview before the City Council are expected to make themselves available. The interview for this position is anticipated for late February or early March. City Council Meetings are Tuesdays at 1:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
