### **BACKGROUND**

The Host Committee recommended the installation of appropriate markers to assist visitors in locating and identifying points of interest in the area.

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to assist visitors in locating and identifying points of interest in the area by appropriate markers supplied by the Host Committee of the Chamber of Commerce.

### **POLICY**

It is the policy of the City of San José that the Public Works Department will install appropriate markers supplied by the Chamber of Commerce Host Committee, and approved by the Public Works Department Sign Section, in the street right-of-way at the following points of interest:

- (a) Civic Center
  - Civic Auditorium
  - Community Theatre
  - Main Library
  - Municipal Airport
  - Municipal Rose Garden
  - San José State College
  - Alum Rock Park
  - Kelley Park
- (b) Rosicrucian Museum
  - Buddhist Temple
  - Frontier Village
  - Others as selected

The costs of installation for all public facilities, as identified in (a) above, is to be charged against the Public Works Department's Operating Budget, while the costs of installation of markers in front of points of interest other than public facilities, as identified in (b) above, is to be paid by the owners of the property to the City prior to installation.
