## **1. Welcome, Introductions and Adoption of the December 10, 2010 Policy Team Minutes**

## **2. Climate Discussion**

Chief Moore deferred the climate report to Lt. John Spicer from the gang investigation unit. Lt. Spicer reported that overall gang crime activity has been up in the early months of the new year but mentioned that last year the city saw the same rise but ended up with a low of 6 gang homicides in 2010.

## **4. Subcommittee Updates**

Council member Rose Herrera reported on behalf of Vice Mayor Nguyen who was absent due to illness. Council Member Herrera reported on the mission, vision and strategic goals of the subcommittee. Additionally the Community engagement subcommittee successfully hosted the third annual Crime and Gang Prevention Summit. The summit successfully hosted 300 community members

with over 20 community based organizations offering various resources. Finally, the subcommittee continues working with the Faith community to formalize the partnership with the city.

Angel Rios reported on behalf of the Interagency subcommittee. Angel Rios reported on the mission, vision and strategic goals of the subcommittee. Additionally Mr. Rios reported that a delegation of city staff and elected officials will be flying to Washington D.C in early April to attend the National Forum on Youth Violence Prevention hosted by the Department of Justice.

Steve Nordseth reported on behalf of the Technical Team subcommittee. Steve Nordseth reported on the mission, vision and strategic goals of the subcommittee.

John Porter Jr., Superintendent of Franklin McKinley School District, reported on behalf of the City School Collaborative. In partnership with the MGPTF the FMCI is actively working to keep the kids in the zone safe.

#### **5. B.E.S.T. Annual Report**

Dr. Peter Ellis reported on the B.E.S.T annual report. The report measures the effectiveness and efficiency of the Task Force based on data collected throughout the year. Dr. Ellis mentioned that the Members of the Task Force felt that the Technical and Policy Team effectiveness has increased since the restructuring of the body.

#### **6. ACT Strategic plan update**

Angel Rios, Deputy Director of Parks Recreation and Neighborhood Services, recommended that the Policy Body provide direction to staff to move forward with adding two strategic goals: Re-entry and Private/Public Partnerships. These two strategic goals will keep the Task Force updated without completely overhauling the Strategic Work Plan. The extended work plan will guide the Task Force until 2013.

Mayor Reed stated that he will be releasing a memo updating the Task Force policy team members and assignments before the April 22, 2011 Policy team meeting.
