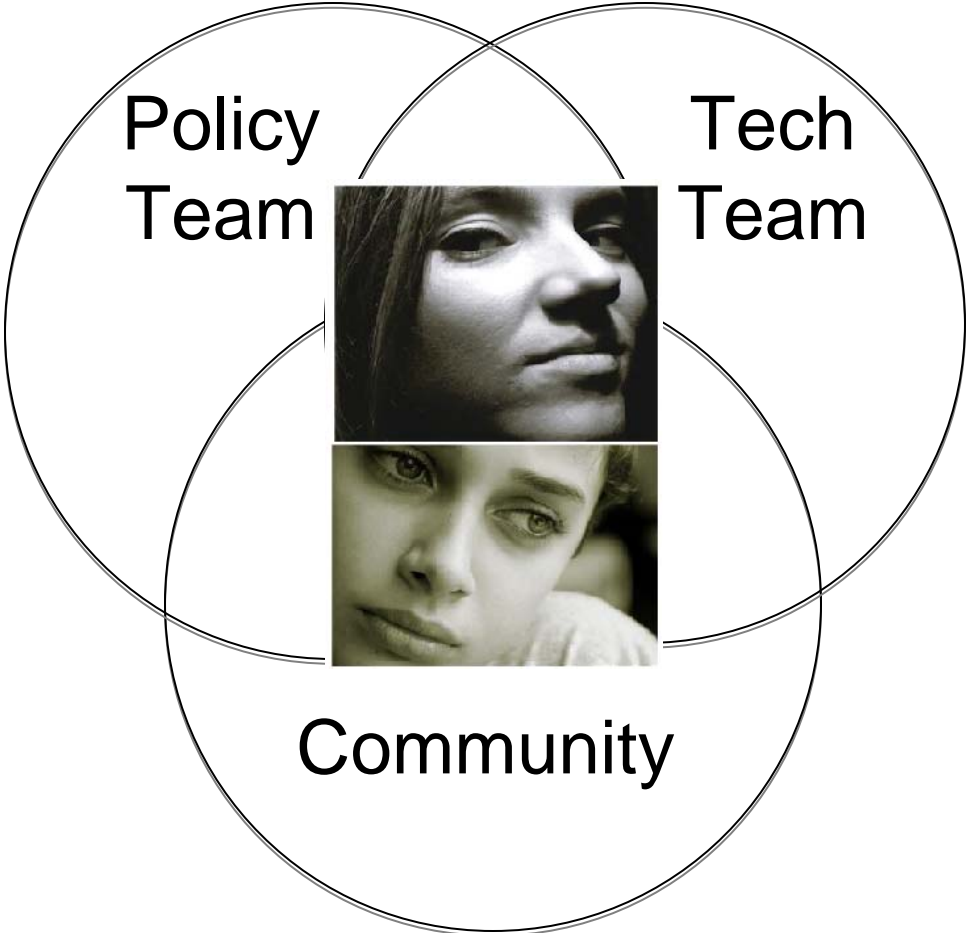

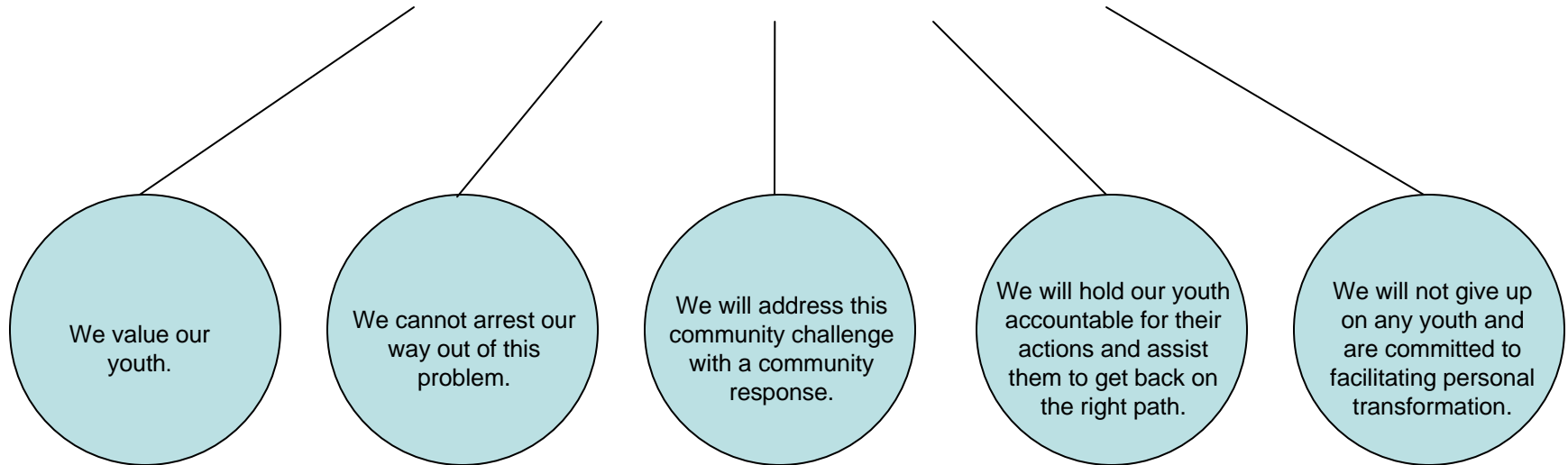

Strategic Goal #6 Continued

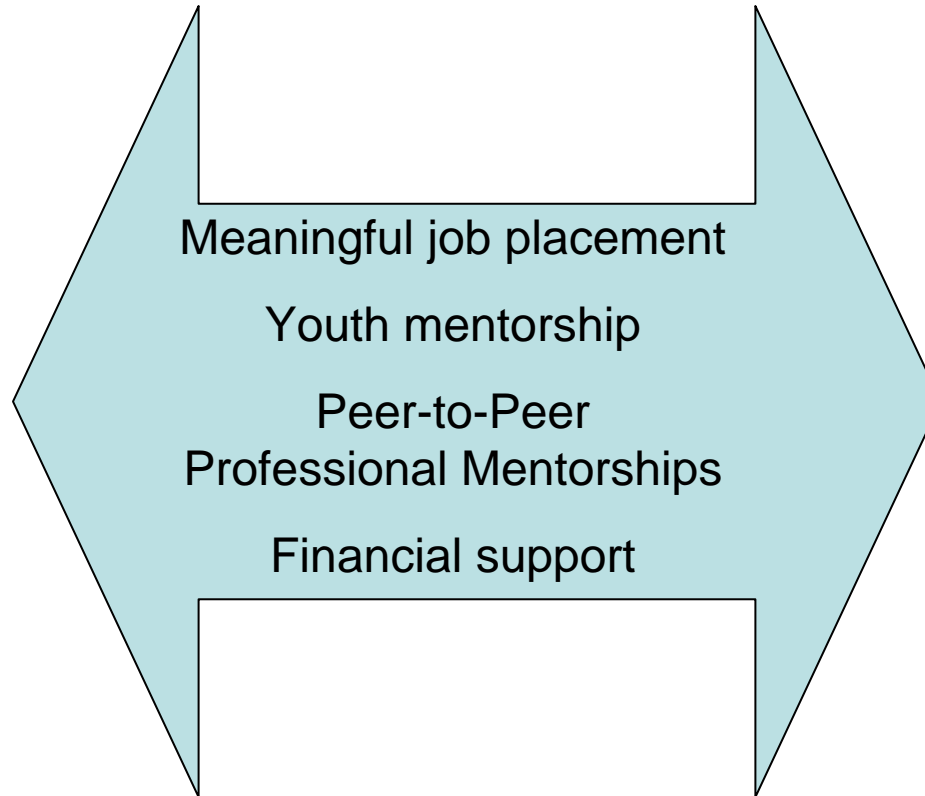
Re-Entry Focus:
