Clearly placing another grocery operation centered between these two already existing neighborhood commercial sites will do nothing but harm them. As Realtors and residents of the Evergreen Community we believe that it is extreme important to keep all parts of the area in the best possible condition.

If the Cosentino's and Lunardi's food markets fail, then the adjoining tenants will suffer greatly and begin to fail as well. It is obvious to expect that the existing centers will be condemned to becoming blighted third rate shopping centers.
