CHESS BASICS

Feed your mind with a fun and challenging game. Introduction to chess mats, pieces and how they move, and set up and clean up. Learn rules and basic strategies to develop your game. This is a skill that few people have, and is sure to test and challenge your mind as you learn the game.

COMPUTER BASICS

This computer class will get you through the basics on a PC computer. We will show you how to turn on your computer, use your mouse and navigate the internet. Once you are comfortable with your computer, we will show you how to create basic documents using Microsoft Word and Excel to name a few.

FILM MAKING 1

MATH MENTORING

Math tutoring will give your child the confidence needed to succeed and feel more confident in Math. Students must bring their math homework, math book and own pencil and paper to each class.

PUBLIC SPEAKING

Effective public speaking skills are beneficial and needed in today's highly competitive culture. Public speaking is a crucial skill that can be used in school, the workforce and in everyday life. This course will cover strategies for organizing and delivering speeches and will build confidence. Set yourself apart from the rest by becoming an effective communicator!

READING REMEDIES

Reading Remedies course is designed to improve your child's vocabulary, spelling and reading comprehension. Parents will need to provide reading materials requested by the instructor. Please bring a pencil and lined paper to each class. Student to staff ratio is kept low in order to give your child individual attention.

SIGN LANGUAGE- BEGINNING

Communicate using signed English. Learn useful conversations and greetings in simple sentences. New vocabulary weekly includes finger spelling and use of numbers. Take part in simple conversations requiring asking and answering questions. Continue to improve and add to your vocabulary.

SPANISH FOR ADULTS

Do you wish you could converse in Spanish at work, home, with friends or during your travels? This class will help you understand and speak Spanish in almost any situation. Vocabulary, grammar, and useful phrases will be taught by a native Spanish speaker. No previous knowledge of Spanish is required.
