## CAN I MAKE A RESERVATION FOR A PICNIC AT MY NEIGHBORHOOD PARK?

Ten (10) neighborhood parks have reservable picnic areas varying in size from 40 to 240 person capacities. There are still many non-reservable sites available at the other neighborhood parks on a first come, first served basis. Parks may sometimes be reserved for a major community-serving event requiring a special permit, but not for private parties.

San Jose's Regional Parks have several picnic areas available for reservation for a fee. Prices vary according to size and amenities. Reservations for picnics can be made in person, M-F, 8:30am - 4:30pm at Leininger Center, 1300 Senter Road.
