CHANT COURT AND KOLLMAR DRIVE SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT

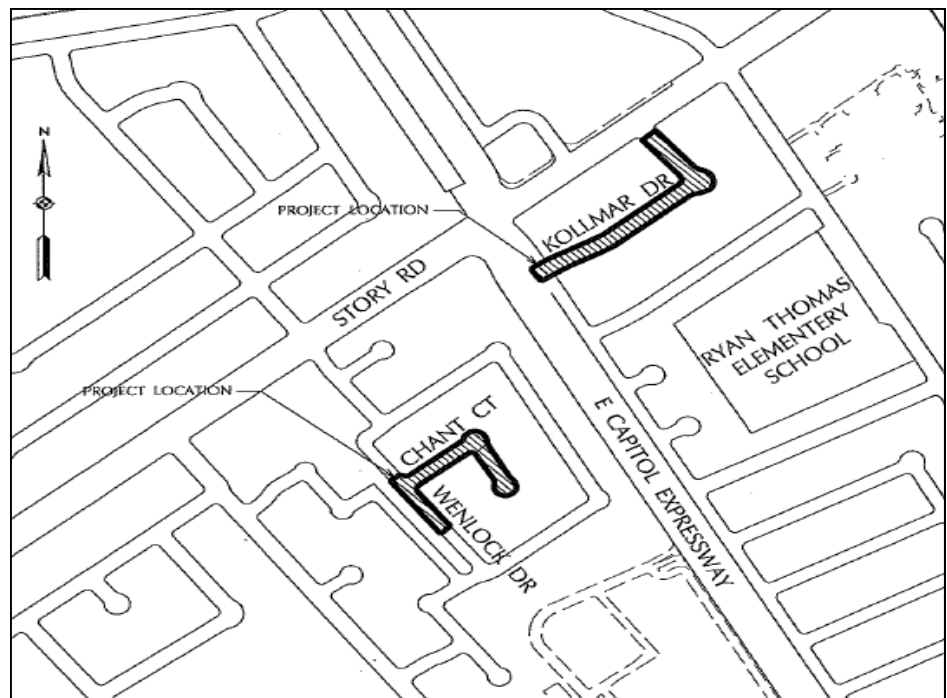
The City of San Jose Department of Public Works along with D'Arcy & Harty Construction, Inc., will start construction on a sanitary sewer improvement project in your neighborhood. The project will involve the removal and replacement of 1400 feet of 6-inch diameter cast iron pipe with ductile iron pipe.

The existing sewers were built between 1950-1970 and require frequent maintenance by the City's Department of Transportation staff.

Streets Impacted

- Chant Court and Wenlock Avenue between Logsden Way and Brenford Drive
- Kollmar Drive between Story Road and S. Capitol Avenue

CHANT COURT AND KOLLMAR DRIVE SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Scope of Work

- Remove and replace approximately 1400 feet of sanitary sewer pipe
- Remove and replace six sanitary sewer manholes and rehabilitate five
- Other related repairs and improvements to the sanitary sewer along the project route

Construction Cost

- \$494,586

- Estimated Start: Mid February 2011
- Estimated Completion: May 2011

Temporary Construction Impacts

- Temporary construction traffic controls and partial lane closures will be in place.
- On-street parking may be temporarily impacted. “ Tow-Away No Parking” signs will be posted at least 24 hours prior to parking restrictions going into effect.
- Prior to start of construction, the contractor will issue a 7-day notice and a 48-hour notice to affected residents and businesses within the project area.
