

PROJECT: Lower Silver Creek Trail - Reach 6 (Dobern Bridge to Foxdale Drive)

General Description:

The Lower Silver Creek Trail is an important piece of a greater vision: a citywide trail network composed of 32 trail systems and over 100 miles of recreational and commuting opportunities. The trail network will link the various neighborhoods and communities of San Jose to important destinations throughout the city as well as regional trail networks such as the San Francisco Bay Trail and Bay Area Ridge Trail.

Currently the existing Lower Silver Creek Trail — Reach 6 trail (in PG&E corridor) is an 8 feet wide concrete path in Capitol Park between Bambi Lane and Van Winkle Lane and a 10 feet wide concrete path in Our Park between Van Winkle Lane and Story Road.

The Lower Silver Creek Trail — Reach 6 (Dobern Bridge to Foxdale Drive) Project will widen the existing concrete path from 8 to a minimum of 10 feet wide to meet the current City standards for trails. This project will also replace damaged concrete path along the Capitol Park and construct a new gateway structure. The project also includes the installation of directional signage and furnishings such as trash cans, bollards, and signs to improve the trail.

Cost: \$ 300,000 Construction (Estimate)

Schedule: Design Phase — November 2011
Bid & Award — December 2011
Construction — February 2012
Beneficial Use — June 2012
