

PROJECT: LOBUE PARK RENOVATION PROJECT

General Description: Lobue Park is an existing 5.1-acre park located at the corner of Muirfield Drive and Sierra Meadow Drive, in east San Jose (map attached). The addition of a ten feet wide walkway along the back of the park with additional lighting will create a looped pedestrian walking route and improve access for maintenance vehicles. The landscaping throughout the park will be renovated in order to improve the efficiency of the existing irrigation system and reduce water usage. New landscaping with meandering walkways, meadow grasses and drought tolerant plantings will replace over one acre of conventional turf. These plants are more drought tolerate and will provide habitat for wildlife, which will create a more sustainable site. The City is providing the funding for the park improvements.

Schedule: Construction Start July 2010
