## **PROJECT: Story Road and Capitol Expressway Street Improvement**

**General Description:** The scope of the project includes the construction of new curb, gutter, sidewalk, street pavement, driveways, wheelchair ramps, street trees and street lights.

This project will also include traffic signal modifications at two intersections:

- **White Road and Story Road** - A second southbound left turn lane will be installed at the intersection of White Road and Story Road with an associated traffic signal modification.
- **Story Road at Capitol Expressway** - The south side of Story Road at Capitol Expressway will be widened to add a third eastbound through lane with an associated traffic signal modification. This improvement is designed to accommodate the future addition of a second westbound left turn lane to be constructed by others as part of a private development traffic mitigation.

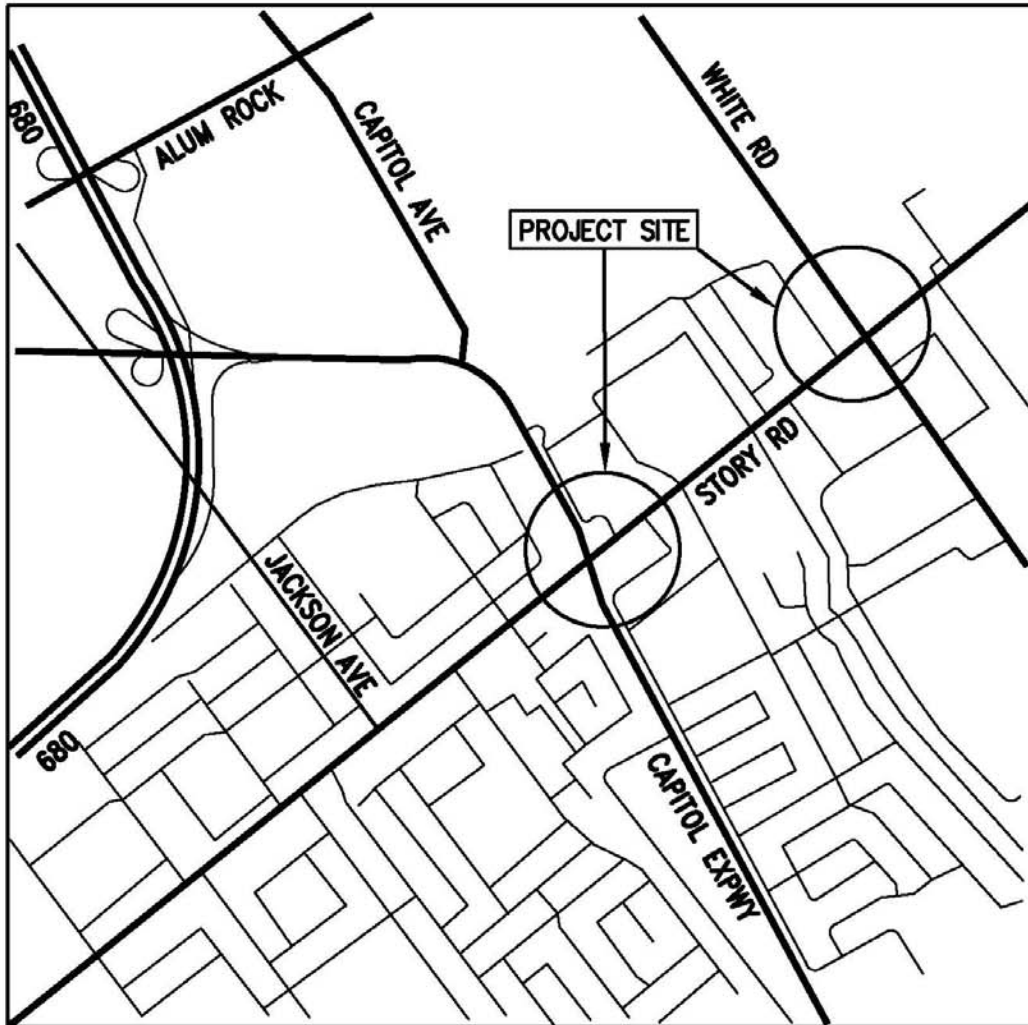
**Total Project Cost:** Estimated Cost: \$990,062
