Award Description\*

The award of Recovery Act grant funds by the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation allows the City of San Jose and its tributary partners in the South Bay Water Recycling (SBWR) Program to invest in new water recycling facilities with an estimated total cost of \$14.78 million. Funding will allow for the construction of eight separate water recycling construction packages that will add approximately 9 miles to the SBWR distribution system, initially increasing recycled water use by up to 1,400 acre-feet per year (AFY), with an additional 600 AFY of reuse potential.

10.45	During Q3 2011, a total of 5,435.85 hours were supported by the SBWR Phase 1C ARRA Program. Based on the approved methodology for calculating jobs created/retained by ARRA, this translates to 10.45 FTEs. (5,435.85/520 hours). Jobs that have been created included foremen, journeymen, laborers, equipment operators, professional services, construction managers and engineers.

On September 6, 2011, the Bureau of Reclamation approved an extension to the ARRA grant from September 30, 2011 to January 15, 2012 to complete construction as administered by the City of San Jose.

**Infrastructure Purpose and Rationale**

The SBWR Phase 1C Improvements will allow for the construction of \$14.78 million worth of recycled water projects in the Cities of San Jose and Santa Clara. Constructing the eight project packages included in the Phase 1C Improvements will add approximately nine miles to the SBWR distribution system, initially increasing deliveries of recycled water by over 1,400 acre-feet per year (AFY), with an additional 600 AFY or reuse potential.
