**Award Description\***

As a Solar America City, San Jose is proud to partner with key stakeholders and the Department of Energy to implement a strategic plan that will result in a 15% increase of solar installations, a 50% increased awareness and knowledge of solar opportunities and more opportunities to purchase or invest in green power. Over the 24-month period of the grant award, the City will implement educational strategies to foster community involvement in innovative and replicable activities that will spur solar market penetration and assist in achieving the goals of San Jose's Green Vision. Key objectives of the award are to:

- 1) Provide coordinated education and outreach activities on energy financing strategies to property owners;
- 2) Increase awareness of the viability and range of solar technologies and opportunities by ensuring the community has a mixture of hands-on and other educational opportunities; and
- 3) Increase available resources for green collar workforce training.

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**Quarterly Activities/Project Description\***

The Green Vision Clean Energy Showcase (Showcase) was completed in late 2010 and serves as a hub for disseminating information on solar and other energy efficient and renewable technologies. Tours of the Showcase are available for schools, professional organizations, and the general public to view the demonstrations and receive information on innovative financing options. The Showcase has continued to attract local, national and international media attention and has been prominently mentioned in several clean energy/technology blogs and news articles. During Q3, a major media campaign was launched to help promote public tours. This included developing print ads and a tv commercial. The staff also undertook the planning for a Solar Home Tour on October 1st. The goal is to get neighbors talking to neighbors about the benefits of going solar. As of September 30th, over 265 people had registered for the solar home tour.
