- (b) **Approve Order of Business** – Approved.
- (c) **Public Forum** – No public comments
- (d) **Approve Minutes of March 8, 2010** - Motion: Halem moved approval, Avanzino seconded. The Motion passed 6-0-0.
- (e) **Old Business**

**(1) Discuss Informal FY09-10 Committee Priorities**

**A. Safe Routes to School** – The committee asked who funds active speed displays. Mr. Brazil will investigate and report back.

**B. Marketing/Promotion of Bicycling & Walking** – The committee asked if a bike maps exists showing current bike lane projects. Mr. Brazil said *Bike Plan 2020* shows all planned bikeways, including the projects planned for this year.

**C. Expanding Use of Sharrows** – No new information.

**D. Connecting Bikeways/Annual Bike Lane Workplan** – Mr. Brazil reported that DOT is making progress on ten to twelve projects to be implemented this year. He will report back on status at the next committee meeting.

**(2) VTA Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee** – Chairperson Bell reported that VTA is continuing development of its Bike Share Pilot Project, of which the City of San Jose is a partner.

**(3) Bike to Work Day Planning** – Mr. Brazil summarized Bike to Work Week activities, which in the south bay are organized by the Silicon Valley Bicycle Coalition. He also requested additional volunteers to staff the City of San Jose Energizer Station on the morning of Bike to Work Day, May 13, 2010. San Jose will also be hosting a variety of bicycling events and activities as part of its San Jose Cycling Classic week of events from May 15-20, 2010. These include the ViaVelo street fair, the King of the Mountain ride, the Bike Movie night, and the Get Back on Your Bike bicycling class. - (f) Staff Report** – Mr. Brazil reported that, due to a \$116m city budget deficit, the Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee, in addition to many other city committees, will change to a quarterly meeting schedule. - (h) Member Comments** – Member Babcock reported on the upcoming biannual Zero1 art festival, including an exhibit and small grant focusing on sustainable transportation.
