Stroller Safari (AGES 10 MONTHS-2 YEARS WITH AN ADULT)

This three-part class is for adults with infants and/or toddlers who want to learn more about the zoo and its residents! Enjoy a stroll through Happy Hollow to view different exhibits each week and meet an animal ambassador up close. Learn how to make animal exhibits engaging for young children and stay after class for informal play time to get to know other zoo families. Please respect age restrictions and do not bring older/younger siblings to class. Class fee is for one child and one adult. Each additional participant requires an additional fee.

Animal Antics

Learn why animals do what they do and why they are so good at doing it! We'll discover how animals hunt, move, socialize, and more!

Home Sweet Home

Stroll through Africa, walk through wetlands, and bounce through the barnyard to learn how animals live in different habitats around the world.

Playtime at the Zoo

People aren't the only ones who play... many animals practice their survival skills and make friends while having lots of fun, too! Meet some playful pals, and help your child explore through play in our parallel play areas.

Tales for Tots (AGES 2-3 WITH AN ADULT)

Stories come to life in this exciting three-part class. Toddlers and their adults will hear a story and then explore the world of the story through songs, hands-on activities, and meeting live animals. Please respect age restrictions and do not bring older/younger siblings to class. Class fee is for one child and one adult. Each additional participant requires an additional fee.

Down on the Zoo Farm

Come face to face with some of Happy Hollow's barnyard buddies to discover how people and animals help each other at life on the farm.

What's the Difference

Have you ever wondered why ferrets are furry? Or why snakes have scales? Why do parrots have plumage? Join us to discover the unique differences between mammals, birds, and reptiles that make them look the way they do!

Animal ABCs

We'll practice our ABCs while we learn about animals from A to Z! Span the alphabet while we discover alligators, goats, rabbits, and more!

Wild Science (AGES 4-6)

Explore the wild world of biology in this hands-on class geared to meet CA Science Standards. Each "edutaining" class includes an interactive discussion, inquiry-based activities, and a visit from one of our animals. Join us for a class full of discovery and awe - great for homeschoolers too!

Paleontology 101

Dig deep into the science of paleontology and study the fossils of plants and animals. Discover what these fossils can tell us about the animals that roamed the Earth long ago and meet some of their modern day relatives living at the zoo.

Winged Wonders

Come flap, flutter, and soar with the winged wonders at the zoo! Even though many birds, bats, and insects can fly, each has different kinds of wings. Learn what makes each unique and how they accomplish such a marvelous feat!

Animal Tracks

Tracks, scat, and animal facts - that's what you'll need to know about to become an expert in tracking animals! Learn how animal tracks come in many forms, including footprints, fur, feathers, and even poop!

Jr. Keepers (AGES 7-9)

Does raking, scooping, feeding, enriching, and caring for zoo animals sound fun and interesting to you? Then join our zoo crew! Learn one or more of these zoo keeping skills and help Happy Hollow's zookeepers take care of our zoo animals. Jr. Keepers will explore different aspects of zoo keeping throughout the year.

All About Reptiles

Snakes, lizards, and turtles - oh my! These cold-blooded creatures require special keeper care. From diets and substrates to humidity and more, learn all about this misunderstood animal group of animals!

All About Horses

Walk, trot, or gallop into the world of horses! Learn how to groom, feed, and care for these four-legged beauties in the Double H Ranch.

All About Primates

Primates require special care at the zoo. Join us to learn about their complex social structure, unique medical care, and participate in their enrichment program.

Zooteen Shadow (AGES 10-13)

Are you eager to volunteer at the zoo? Our Zooteen Program starts at age 14, but you can get a head start with our new class, Zooteen Shadow! Join our young mentors to learn the very same tasks that the zookeepers taught them! You'll learn valuable skills in this adult-supervised class.

Join our Meet & Greet Zooteens to learn about and meet some of our animal ambassadors, talk to the public about why the animals are here and their role in their natural environment, and even learn how to handle one of our program animals!

These fun family classes are filled with activities for adults and children to do together. Each class includes interactive discussions, hands-on activities, and live animals! Howl-o-ween Family Sleepover (AGES 5+ WITH AN ADULT)


