## **INFORMATION**

As part of the efforts to reduce General Fund expenditures and maximize the use of City resources, the General Services Department is transforming the old Martin Luther King Library into offices for approximately 350 City staff who are currently in leased facilities. The old library, a building primarily designed for library operations, and built before computers and advanced telecommunications revolutionized work processes and customer service opportunities, was not an ideal candidate for conversion to office use. The work involved extensive refurbishment including the complete rewiring for power, computer and telephone functions. Though GSD staff managed the project and in-house staff performed much of the work, staff from many departments has worked collaboratively on the project. The outcome, achieved in three months, is a structure that meets tenant needs, makes fiscal sense operationally, and provides a laboratory to test some of the new operating methodologies for the new civic center.

Seven divisions from four departments have started the relocation process to the "old library". The schedule below is provided for your information. All efforts will be expended to minimize customer impact by referring calls and providing alternative service areas where applicable. In almost all cases telephone numbers remain and the City's Call Center can be of assistance if needed during the interim.
