On Thursday, May 15, 2008, the Housing Department, in cooperation with County social services departments and member agencies of the Santa Clara County Collaborative on Housing and Homeless Issues, is sponsoring its sixth Project Homeless Connect (PHC) event. The event will take place from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM at Exhibit Hall 1 of the McEnery Convention Center, located at 150 West San Carlos Street in Downtown San José.

Project Homeless Connect is a coordinated effort to connect persons who are homeless and atrisk of becoming homeless to a range of medical and dental resources; housing referrals and assistance; General Assistance and food stamps; personal hygiene kits and gift bags; legal assistance, and other key resources that can help them on their path to self-sufficiency.

The previous five PHC events were great achievements – over 1,500 homeless and at-risk individuals were provided direct services and assistance, while over 500 residents and employees from the City of San José and corporations such as IBM, Adobe, and CISCO volunteered. PHC is an important step in the City's 10-Year Strategy to End Chronic Homelessness.

We would be honored to have you join us at 1:00 PM on the day of the event to acknowledge the efforts of the participating volunteers and service providers, and share a few words with the individuals seeking assistance.
