I am pleased to announce my selection and the appointment of Teresa L. Deloach Reed to the position of Assistant Fire Chief. Teresa brings extensive skill and experience to her new position that will serve the Fire Department well. She was selected following a national recruitment. She was identified by two interview panels with community members and management staff and through an extensive Leadership and Management Assessment as the top candidate to fill this important position.

Teresa has a rich and extensive 23-year history with the San Jose Fire Department and has served in all ranks of the organization. Hired as a Firefighter EMT in 1986, she promoted to Fire engineer in 1989, and then Fire Inspector in 1991. In 1994 she was promoted to Fire Captain, serving as a Captain Training Officer from 1996 to 1999 during which time she oversaw several recruit academies.
