SUBJECT: AFFORDABLE HOUSING WEEK 2012 **DATE:** May 9, 2012

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#### **INFORMATION**

The week of May 19-26, 2012 will be the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Affordable Housing Week (AHW) in Santa Clara County. The objective of AHW is to share information on affordable housing with the public, to provide information on housing opportunities and to showcase high-quality affordable housing developments throughout the County.

To celebrate AHW, a Planning Committee—led by the Housing Trust of Santa Clara County, the Silicon Valley Leadership Group, the Santa Clara County Office of Affordable Housing and the City of San José Department of Housing—has scheduled a week of events and tours. These AHW events are made possible by collaboration with a group of dedicated partners, including the Bill Wilson Center, Eden Housing, Habitat for Humanity, Neighborhood Housing Services Silicon Valley, Project Sentinel, ROEM, the Silicon Valley Leadership Group, the City of Sunnyvale and West Valley Community Services, in addition to members of the AHW planning committee. AHW is also a time to honor the hard-working families and individuals who strengthen our communities and who power our economy, but who need reasonable-cost housing to live and work in Silicon Valley. The current economic recession has been especially difficult for these households, who have endured job loss, wage reductions, foreclosures or a combination of these results.

The cost of living in Silicon Valley is widely known to be among the highest in the nation. In June 2011, Kiplinger.com named the San José metro area the fourth most expensive cost of living in the U.S. (<u>http://www.kiplinger.com/slideshow/cities-with-most-expensive-cost-of-living-2011/5.html</u>). San José will see the largest increase in rents in the country according to *Multifamily Executive Magazine* (July 14, 2011), which projects rents to rise 12 percent in 2012 following an 11 percent increase in 2011. And according to the United Way, the typical cost of living for a family of four in Santa Clara County increased 22% from 2008 to 2011.

These high housing costs are not typically offset by local incomes, as over 50 percent of renters in Santa Clara County pay too much for housing relative to industry standards. And although the value of owner-occupied homes has declined significantly from the market's peak, over 40 percent of County homeowners still overpay for housing. The need for reasonably-priced housing to support our entire workforce is great, especially as the economy rebounds and jobs return.

Given the current environment, where federal housing and community development programs have been cut significantly, State bond funds have been depleted and California's redevelopment agencies dissolved, we must work harder, smarter, and more collaboratively than ever to try to meet the housing needs of San José's residents. Affordable Housing Week is a testament to the resourcefulness and commitment of our local housing providers to creating housing opportunities for all families and individuals here in our great City.

A proclamation in support of Affordable Housing Week will be presented at the City Council Meeting on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.
