SUBJECT SAN JOSE FIREFIGHTERS BURN FOUNDATION AND LOS BOMBEROS OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA "FILL THE BOOT" FUNDRAISING EVENT

The San José Firefighter's Burn Foundation will be participating in a "Fill the Boot" fundraising campaign on Saturday, November 24, from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the intersection of Almaden Expressway and Blossom Hill Road. All Proceeds will go towards the support and treatment of burn survivors. The San José Firefighter's Burn Foundation has donated thousands of dollars for the care, treatment and rehabilitation of thermal, chemical, contact, electrical and radiation injuries. Nurses from the Valley Medical Center Burn Unit will join fire fighters in a team effort to support this important cause.

They collect new and unwrapped toys donated at all San José Fire Stations and coordinate with other Community Assistance programs to serve families with children in need.
