# Be Safe With Us!

## Rules and guidelines to help make your visit both safe and fun!

The following are **prohibited** in **all** parks:

- » Smoking of any kind
- » Fireworks of any kind
- » Loud speakers or amplified sound
- » Weapons (including airsoft & paintball)
- » Graffiti, defacement & vandalism
- » Littering & unauthorized dumping
- » Damaging/collecting plants, flowers or rocks
- » Feeding or tampering with wildlife
- » Drones/model airplanes and boats
- » Collecting money on site for performers
- » Skating off paved pathways
- » Selling of goods or services without permit

### Alum Rock Park Specific Rules:

- » Beer and wine allowed in picnic areas only
- » No dogs or pets allowed
- » No Air Jumpers or dunk tanks allowed
- » Horses are to progress no faster than a walk
- » Motor vehicles on public roads only
- » No short-cutting across hillsides
- » No balloons allowed
- » No motorized scooters allowed
- » No overnight parking/camping allowed
- » Speed limit 15 mph
- » All Municipal codes and State laws apply

## FUN FACT!

From 1890 to 1932, the park was a nationally known health spa with 27 mineral springs, an indoor swimming pool, tea garden, restaurant, and dance pavilion.
