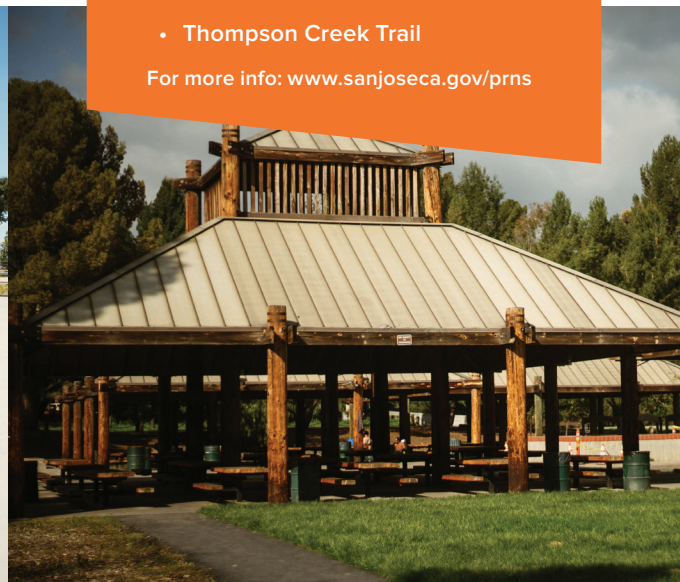

# Be Safe With Us!

## Rules and guidelines to help make your visit both safe and fun!

The following are **prohibited** in **all** parks:

- » Dogs off leash
- » Smoking of any kind
- » Fireworks of any kind
- » Amplified sound
- » Weapons (including airsoft & paintball)
- » Graffiti, defacement & vandalism
- » Littering & unauthorized dumping
- » Damaging or collecting plants
- » Harassing wildlife
- » Drones/model airplanes and boats
- » Collecting money on site for performers/vendors
- » Skating on paved pathways

## Lake Cunningham Regional Park Specific Rules:

- » No helium balloons
- » No kite flying
- » Air Jumpers in approved zones only with permit and picnic reservation
- » No swimming/wading/windsurfing
- » Valid fishing license required for persons 16 years and older
- » No live bait except worms

## FUN FACT!

Great blue herons, snowy egrets, and even white pelicans are frequent visitors to the park. Canada geese, as well as several species of waterfowl, make the park their home.
