SUBJECT: NATIONAL LEAGUE OF CITIES CONGRESSIONAL CITY CONFERENCE MARCH 7-11, 2015

The National League of Cities (NLC) will hold its annual Congressional City Conference in Washington, D.C. at the Marriott Wardman Park Hotel on March 7-11, 2015. This conference serves as an opportunity to meet with members of Congress and the Administration on critical federal funding matters, and members of the Council may wish to participate in the future on NLC Policy Committees. We are providing this information as a courtesy from the City Manager's Office and would appreciate knowing if you are planning on attending and the intended dates of your arrival and departure.

The City of San José has a long history of attending the League's Conferences and participating on the organization's policy committees. As in years past, the conference provides an excellent opportunity for City officials and staff to participate in programs and workshops that offer professional growth, inform participants about successful and innovative community services and educate attendees on critical national issues affecting cities.

The conference begins on Saturday, March 7, with the NLC University Seminars. The sessions are for municipal leaders and consist of a series of educational sessions specifically designed to help officials become more effective. In addition to providing professional growth opportunities, policy development is one of the primary purposes of the annual conference. It provides cities with an opportunity to focus attention on local control and prepare a positive program at the federal level to strengthen cities. The League's policy committees will meet Sunday, March 8 to determine their issue areas for study in 2015.

During the conference attendees will be able to attend legislative briefings, attend workshops and hear from national leaders on key issues of concern to local government. The program will also include general sessions featuring members of the Administration and Congress. The conference will conclude on Wednesday, March 11 with roundtable discussions and briefings on Capitol Hill.

Those interested in attending should fill out the "early bird" registration form and send it in to the NLC no later than January 30. Advance registration will be valid until March 6. Attendees are responsible for their own flight arrangements. **Registrants unable to attend will receive a refund of paid registration, less a \$100 processing charge, if the NLC office receives a written request postmarked no later than February 13, 2015.** After that date, no refunds for registration are available. The deadline for housing cancellations is 72 hours prior to arrival.
