INFORMATION

The City's Department of Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services (PRNS) announces the grand opening of San José's newest destination - a bike park at Lake Cunningham Action Sports Park (LCASP). The ribbon cutting ceremony will take place on Saturday, April 14, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. followed by a weekend of festivities and free admission.

The 8.5-acre bike park offers the most riding features of any bike park in the nation with 45 diverse riding elements to challenge all level of riders and ages. The features are scattered throughout six riding zones: beginner and advanced pump tracks; a dual slalom track; a dirt jump zone; a slopestyle zone; a skills trail; and a drop zone.

The bike park is an addition to the 68,000 square foot Lake Cunningham Skate Park which is the largest skate park in California. Featuring the world's largest cradle, tallest vertical wall, and the largest full pipe. Currently, the skate park is visited by more than 8,600 skaters per year.

LCASP offers a wide variety of terrain for all skill levels to learn and enjoy. The 10-acre action sports park amenities include: five bicycle and skateboard repair stations; shaded patio with heaters and fans; free Wi-Fi; park-wide sound system; shaded picnic areas, and a water misting system. LCASP is an ideal location for premier bike and skate competitions and a San José destination.

The quality park provides residents and visitors a safe place to have fun while staying active. Daily admission cost is \$7.00 for both the skate and bike park. Annual membership is \$119. Daily admission and memberships are available for purchase at the park's Pro Shop during operating hours. Scholarships are also available. San José residents can apply for a scholarship at LCASP or at any community center.
