

About the Park

A 2.1-acre park site is being considered within a proposed new development project that could include up to 1,472 new housing units and approximately 18,965 square-feet of retail space. The park would be located along Seely Avenue, approximately 535 feet north of Montague Expressway and is shown in the picture below.
