PUBLIC NOTICE INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION CITY OF SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

Project Name: 1655 Lincoln Avenue Residential Project

File No.: PDC22-087, PD22-019, T22-029, ER22-189

Description: The project proposes a Planned Development Rezoning (File No. PDC22-087) to rezone the existing 1-gross acre site, from the R-1-8 Zoning District and R-2 Zoning District to the R-1-8 (PD) Planned Development Zoning District, to facilitate the development, subdivision, and construction of five residential lots approximately 3,200-square feet each. The Tentative Map (File No. T22-029) would allow the subdivision of the single lot into five lots and one private street. The Planned Development Permit (File No. PD22-019) would allow the demolition of a single existing single-family home and the construction of five new single-family homes. Four of the new residential lots would also include an accessory dwelling unit (ADU).

Location: The project site is located at 1655 Lincoln Avenue, in the City of San José.

The public comment period for this Draft MND begins on **Tuesday**, **August 8**, **2023** and **ends on Monday**, **August 28**, **2023**.
