35.3 million refugees

5.4 million asylum seekers

REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT

- 1 of 2 resettlement agencies in Santa Clara County
- We are the third largest resettlement agency in the Western US
- Since July 2021, we've resettled 450+ refugees
- Housed over 450 refugees throughout Santa Clara County
- Assisted 150 refugees secure employment that aligns with their education, or careers they had in their home country
- 350 refugees served in our Connection To Work Program (VESL/Career placement)






