- B. City Attorney Deputy City Attorney Matthew Tolnay reported that Assembly Bill 83 from Assemblymember Lee, regarding foreign influence in elections, has gone

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inactive. An ordinance with recommended changes to Title 12 (Ordinance No. 30926), discussed by former Councilmember Maya Esparza and the BFCPP, was approved by the City Council on June 20, 2023. The Board of Fair Campaign and Political Practices' Biennial Review recommendations will be brought back to the City Council on August 29, 2023. An update to Resolution 7987 and an ordinance regarding revolving door exception changes will be included in the BFCPP recommendations that will be discussed on August 29, 2023. Deputy City Attorney Tolnay noted that recent campaign guidance email responses will be included on the September BFCPP agenda, and he answered questions from Vice Chair Tom Pavel and Chair Louis Silver.

- C. City Clerk City Clerk Toni Taber provided an update related to elections. She noted that the 2024 Elections webpage has been updated with a candidate guide and dates of interest for the upcoming election. The campaign contribution period opened on August 8, 2023; contribution limits are \$700 for Councilmember candidates and \$1500 for Mayoral candidates. The Nomination period opens at 8:00 a.m. on November 13, 2023 and closes at 12:00 p.m. on December 8, 2023. City Clerk Taber answered clarifying questions from Vice Chair Tom Pavel and Board Member Gregory Ebert, and confirmed Hanson Bridgett LLP expenditures are available within the spreadsheet attached to the agenda.

A. Discussion on Open Issues Regarding San Jose Municipal Code Title 12, City Council Resolution 79187 and Other Administrative Policies, Including the Complaint Intake Process. (Board)

<u>Discussion</u>: Vice Chair Tom Pavel discussed his memo which outlined the three open issues that the sunsetted Ad Hoc Subcommittee for Officeholder Accounts and Officeholder-Controlled Committees explored. Discussion amongst commissioners, Deputy City Attorney Matthew Tolnay, and City Clerk Toni Taber ensued. The Board agreed that the topic of phone call disclaimers/regulation would be added to the list of open issues.

Action: Upon motion by Vice Chair Tom Pavel, seconded by Board Member Gregory Ebert, and carried unanimously, the Board directed the City Attorney's office to explore future revisions to the Municipal Code that support the idea of requiring disclosures for independent expenditure committees on the full set of officers/board members/decision makers, and to conduct a feasibility analysis on the proposition.
