

The San José-Santa Clara Regional Wastewater Facility's (RWF) Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is rebuilding and modernizing the RWF so that its critical work can continue. The CIP envisions an investment of approximately \$2.1 billion over 30 years.

The City of San José (City) has consolidated all procurement solicitations to post on Biddingo (<u>https://www.biddingo.com/sanjose</u>). All bid documents, questions and answers, addenda, and results will be available electronically via Biddingo during the procurement process. Interested firms must register on Biddingo to receive notifications when procurements are posted.

The City plans to advertise the following procurements within the next six months.

Main Guard Shack February 2024 \$6,800,000 This project will replace the aging guard shack at the main entrance to the RWF with Replacement an ADA-compliant guard shack with a restroom, additional security features, improved lighting, improved traffic circulation, utility relocation, new asphalt pavement and a pedestrian walkway.
