2023-2024 CULTURAL GRANT AWARDS

By Ordinance, the Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) Fund provides funding for Convention Facilities Operations and Maintenance, Cultural Development, and the San José Convention and Visitors Bureau. TOT revenues allocated for Cultural Development provide funding for the cultural grant and Office of Cultural Affairs (OCA) programs. Each year, the OCA promotes grant opportunities and solicits applications. Applications for funding are evaluated based on guidelines and criteria approved by the City Council. Grant awards are made based on a competitive application-based peer review process and available funding.

The City Council-adopted *Cultural Connection: San José's Cultural Plan* reflects the strategic goals and top priorities for cultural development in San José. A key strategy to advance the goals of *Cultural Connection* is through partnerships and grant agreements with community-based organizations and creative entrepreneurs across grant program areas aimed at promoting cultural vibrancy, cultural diversity, and economic development in San José, including:

- <u>Operating Grants</u> provide financial support for selected San José arts organizations of various disciplines, sizes and stages of development.
- <u>Festival, Parade & Celebration Grants</u> enable access for all City residents to a wide range of diverse cultural events, large and small. These events are often held in public spaces and are always open to the public.
- <u>take pART Grants</u> support arts activities offered by volunteer-driven arts organizations, community service organizations, and small semi-professional and professional arts organizations.
- <u>Capitalization and Sustainability Grants</u> support activities of nonprofit art organizations that will increase their working financial capital and promote fiscal soundness.
- <u>Programmatic Partnerships</u> advance the goals and recommendations outlined in *Cultural Connection*.

Grant awards are based on available funding and cultural development funding priorities. Initial recommendations are reviewed by a panel of Arts Commissioners, arts and culture professionals, and community representatives; forwarded to the Arts Commission for formal review; and then submitted for the City Council's approval as part of the annual budget process.

San José's arts and culture sector continues to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic that caused significant revenue losses from programming, admissions, and fundraising events, even leading to the closure of some arts organizations. Transient Occupancy Tax revenue, the primary funding source for City support, continued to rebound in 2022-2023 but remains significantly lower than pre-pandemic levels.

To support the City's arts and cultural partners, the 2023-2024 Adopted Operating Budget includes \$1.0 million of supplemental funding from the General Fund for Small Business Recovery – Supplemental Arts + Cultural Funding initiatives as part of the City's continued community and economic recovery efforts, as well as \$5.4 million from the Transient Occupancy Tax Fund for grants and initiatives managed by the Office of Cultural Affairs. Of this amount, \$4.1 million is allocated toward individual grant awards, as recommended by the Arts Commission on May 16, 2023 and detailed below.

Remaining funds will support other cultural development programs and initiatives managed by the Office of Cultural Affairs, including: technical assistance grant programs for nonprofit art organizations and creative entrepreneurs; Creative License Ambassador commissions; arts marketing; City Hall exhibits; Cornerstone of the Arts Awards; special events like CityDance and Make Music Day; and public art maintenance, among others.
