“THE IPA ROADSHOW” HITS THE AIRWAVES

San José – A new local cable television show, featuring the City of San Jose’s Independent Police Auditor (IPA), Judge LaDoris H. Cordell (Ret.), will debut Wednesday, February 8, 2012, at 7 P.M. The show, entitled “The IPA Roadshow” will air on CreaTV’s Silicon Valley Cable Channel 30. The first episode will feature Judge Cordell’s interview of San Jose Police Chief, Christopher Moore.

In addition to hosting the program, Judge Cordell collaborated with Executive Producer Alison Nicole Stewart to produce each episode. Future episodes feature interviews of the former Mexican Consul General of San Jose, and a SJPD Internal Affairs sergeant, as well as conversations with members of the Independent Police Auditor’s Teen Leadership Program. Each month, CreaTV will air one episode of The IPA Roadshow series, Wednesdays at 7 P.M. Comcast Cable subscribers in San Jose can watch the show on Silicon Valley Channel 30 every Wednesday, and via live stream and video on demand at www.CreaTVsj.org.

The Office of the Independent Police Auditor was created in 1993 to provide oversight of the citizen complaint process, analyze patterns and trends regarding police conduct and make recommendations for improvements in policies, procedures and training to the San José Police Department. Judge Cordell was appointed to the position of Independent Police Auditor (IPA) by Mayor Chuck Reed and the San Jose City Council in April of 2010. Since her appointment, she has considerably expanded the community outreach performed by the IPA Office. The “IPA Roadshow” is an example of that outreach effort.
