- B. City Attorney Deputy City Attorney Matthew Tolnay reported that he anticipates presenting a proposed ordinance to the City Council regarding foreign influence in December. Deputy City Attorney Tolnay also discussed a campaign guidance inquiry to which he responded. In response to a previous research request from the Board, he reported that text messages are excluded from the Municipal Code's definition of advertisements, but the Political Reform Act has disclosure requirements that apply to text messages. He noted that he hopes to report on the Board's research request on Op-Eds and independent committees during the next BFCPP meeting. Discussion with the Board ensued.
- C. City Clerk –City Clerk Toni Taber noted that the nomination period for the March primary election will start on Monday November 13, 2023 and end at 12:00 p.m. on December 8, 2023. Meetings with candidates are underway. City Clerk Taber also noted that this is the first time the Mayor will be elected during a presidential year election cycle, the eligible seats for the March election are Mayor and Councilmembers for Districts 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10, and Districts 4, 8, and 10 have incumbents. There were no new Hanson Bridget LLP expenditures to report. Discussion with the Board ensued.
