A. Actions Related to the Purchase Order with Hasa Inc. for Liquid 12.5% Sodium Hypochlorite

#### **Staff Recommendation to Committee for City Council:**

Adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager or her designee to:

- (a) Amend purchase order OP 63603 with Hasa Inc. (Saugus, CA) for Liquid 12.5% Sodium Hypochlorite to increase the total compensation by \$1,950,000, for a revised maximum compensation not-to-exceed \$3,380,000 for the period ending on or about June 30, 2024; and
- (b) Execute additional annual purchase orders for ongoing Liquid 12.5% Sodium Hypochlorite purchases pursuant to competitive solicitations facilitated by the Bay Area Chemical Consortium, subject to the appropriation of funds.

- (a) Amend purchase order OP 63578 with Kemira Water Solutions, Inc. (Lawrence, KS) for ferric chloride to increase the total compensation by \$2,000,000, for a revised maximum compensation not-to-exceed \$3,430,000 for the period ending on June 30, 2024; and
- (b) Execute additional annual purchase orders for ongoing ferric chloride purchases pursuant to competitive solicitations facilitated by the Bay Area Chemical Consortium, subject to the appropriation of funds.

C. Actions Related to the 7760 – Facility-Wide Water Systems Improvements Project at the San Jose-Santa Clara Regional Wastewater Facility

#### **Staff Recommendation to Committee for City Council:**

- (a) Accept the report on bids and award of a contract for the construction of 7760 Facility-wide Water Systems Improvements Project to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Ranger Pipelines, Inc., in the amount of \$59,490,760.
- (b) Approve a 15% contingency in the amount of \$8,923,614.
- (c) Adopt the following 2023-2024 Appropriation Ordinance Amendments in the San José-Santa Clara Treatment Plant Capital Fund:
  - (1) Decrease the Support Building Improvements appropriation to the Environmental Services Department by \$8,000,000; and
  - (2) Increase the Facility Wide Water Systems Improvements appropriation to the Environmental Services Department by \$8,000,000.
- (d) Adopt the Addendum to the Environmental Impact Report for the San José-Santa Clara Regional Water Pollution Control Plant Master Plan (SCH #2011052074), Facility-wide Water Systems Improvements Project, File No. ER20-209, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), as amended.

D. Amendment to the Master Consultant Agreement with Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, Inc., for Engineering Services for the 7760 – Facility Wide Water Systems Improvements Project

#### **Staff Recommendation to Committee for City Council:**

Approve the Second Amendment to the Master Consultant Agreement with Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, Inc., for engineering services for the Facility Wide Water Systems Improvements project at the San José-Santa Clara Regional Wastewater Facility,

increasing the amount of compensation by \$3,000,000, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$8,370,000; and extending the term of agreement from December 31, 2025, to December 31, 2027.
