The San José Fire Department is currently seeking an **Intern** to work in our Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Division, 20 hours per week (flexible schedule), with an hourly rate of \$18.87-\$27.87 hourly. This position will run until 6/30/24 with an option to extend.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- + 18 years old at time of application
- + Any combination of training and experience equivalent to the completion of a bachelor's degree and current enrollment in a master's degree program from an accredited college or university in business or public administration or a closely related field
- + Valid California driver's license

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

- + California EMT Certification or National Registry/EMT Basic Certification
- Basic proficiency in Microsoft Office programs such as Outlook, Excel, and Word for development of spreadsheets, evaluation forms, and other documents

RESPONSIBILITIES

The San José Fire Department EMS Division coordinates the effective delivery of pre-hospital emergency medical care to the community of San José through sworn uniformed members who are either trained to the Paramedic or Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) level of patient care. Interns will contribute to the EMS Division's efforts through community education and awareness campaigns that focus on the dangers of opioids and the importance of administering naloxone to rapidly reverse the effects of a possible overdose. This work will be valuable to SJFD's mission to save lives through community education. Interns will gain experience in social and traditional media campaigns, digital art creation, analytical research, and partnering with community stakeholders and elected officials.
