Single- or multifamily building owner submits completed <u>Incentive</u> <u>Eligibility Application</u> form and works with a <u>TECH</u> certified contractor.

Contractor submits
Pre-Installation
Application form.

City of San José approves application, reserves incentive for up to 180 days, and sends email notice.

START THE PROJECT

Contractor applies for a City of San José building permit by visiting the City of San José Permit Center.

Building owner contracts directly with a <u>TECH certified contractor</u> to complete the project.

SUBMIT INSTALLATION VERIFICATION



INCENTIVE APPROVAL & DISBURSEMENT

After the project is complete, contractor submits the <u>Post-Installation Application</u> packet within 180 days of the approved <u>Pre-Installation Application</u>. Failure to submit within 180 days may result in loss of incentive.

The City of San José approves

Post-Installation Application and sends
email notice. Incentive is paid out and
mailed within 6 weeks of submitting all
required documentation.

Building owner will submit all applications themselves if they choose to complete projects through self-installation.
