## DRIVE SAFELY



### SLOW DOWN

Speed limits save lives. The safe speed may be below the posted speed.



### LOOK FOR PEOPLE CROSSING

Look for people crossing in crosswalks, intersections, and also where you don't expect them, especially at night.



### PUT AWAY DISTRACTIONS

Set your cell phone to silence notifications while driving. Keep your eyes on the road, your hands on the wheel, and your attention on driving safely.



### WATCH THE DOOR

Look around before opening any car door; be sure to check behind you for people bicycling.

## WALK SAFELY



### BE VISIBLE

Make eye contact with drivers before crossing the street. Add a pocket flashlight to your keychain to have when it's dark out.



### STOP, LOOK, AND LISTEN

For cars (including from behind!) before crossing. Look left, right, left, and behind you.



### CROSS IN CROSSWALKS

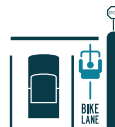
Cross at street corners and marked crosswalks. Drivers do not expect to see you in other places.

## BIKE, SKATE, & SCOOT SAFELY



### USE A HELMET

Protect your brain. Fit your helmet snug and level on your head just above your eyebrows.



### BE PREDICTABLE

Follow all signs, signals, and rules of the road, just like a driver. Use hand signals before turning.



### BE CAUTIOUS

Pay attention at driveways. Maintain a safe distance from parked cars to avoid collisions with opening doors.
