It would provide economic benefit as guests may buy food and supplies for their picnics and an additional band would have an opportunity to earn income which could be potentially invested in San Jose. It also makes the neighborhood safer as neighbors get to know each other better and start looking out for each other, noticing suspicious activities if they occur. And at a time when loneliness is on the rise, especially in our senior population, this request would provide one more socializing opportunity to combat that loneliness.

BD Cost Estimate Notes (if applicable – provide any notes only if necessary to clarify the cost estimate):

Although the costs of providing an additional event are limited, there are other factors to consider, including the lead time involved in planning this annual event and the impact to the neighborhood, school, and park. Historically, for the past 21 years, the series has consisted of four concerts scheduled for the month of July. The decision to keep the series at four events and not expand in the past is based on feedback from the Greystone Park neighborhood community. They have expressed concerns with expansion beyond four concerts due to the impacts on parking, noise, and the extensive use of park space during the events.

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The following items would need to be coordinated if a fifth concert date was added:

- Update of the existing approved Special Park Use (SPU) permit with electrical access for four dates. Staff would need to communicate with the SPU team to amend the contract and include the additional date.
- Dumpster drop-off and pick-ups are coordinated with the Environmental Service Department for the four events. An additional day would need to be coordinated.
- Bands are scheduled for four Thursdays. Staff would need to identify one additional available band and pick the date.
- Marketing materials have been approved and distributed for the four concerts only. Staff would need to make adjustments to our promotional marketing materials to include the fifth concert.

The Department would request that if this proposal were approved, it would be implemented for the 2025 Summer Concert Series, to allow for the proper coordination and planning of the event, particularly community outreach.
