Proposal Description, including the reason for the need and anticipated outcomes (Please describe how the proposal will affect services for San José residents, community groups, businesses, etc.):

Proclaimed in both May of 2023 and 2024 by Councilmember Peter Ortiz, there is a nationwide epidemic of violence against indigenous people, especially women and girls. For years, unsolved abductions and femicides have devastated indigenous families and communities, who then face inattention or outright stonewalling from law enforcement and federal authorities. For Native Americans, this adds one more layer of trauma upon existing wounds that cannot heal.

This funding will support the initiatives of the Red Earth Women's Society: Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women (MMIW), campaign of awareness, advocacy, and action here in Santa Clara County. The Indian Health Center of Santa Clara Valley serves as a fiscal sponsor to the Red Earth Women's Society and will disburse the funds appropriately.
