Proposal Description, including the reason for the need and anticipated outcomes (Please describe how the proposal will affect services for San José residents, community groups, businesses, etc.):

YSI provides hands-on experiences with live animals, indigenous history, habitat education and geology at Alum Rock Park. This outdoor education programming has served as a great way to broaden the horizons of children and ensure that they get to take advantage of the natural resources Alum Rock Park has to offer.

I request funding to help support free programs and transportation for children in Title 1 schools in Santa Clara County. As transportation costs to YSI's Alum Rock Park location can present a barrier, I propose utilizing the funding to cover both bus and program costs. A typical bus costs \$500 and a typical YSI program costs \$315 and serves 26 students. With a grant of \$62,500, YSI would be able to serve approximately 2,000 children and remove a financial barrier to ensure all children are given the opportunity to participate in educational programs. With a grant of \$200,000 the number of children served would be 6,380. I've added both options to this document in the case that other offices are willing to support this regionally beneficial education program.
