GovAI Coalition Mission

Promote responsible and purposeful artificial intelligence (AI) in the public sector

- ▶ Using AI for social good,
- ▶ Ensuring ethical, non-discriminatory, and responsible AI governance,
- ▶ Promoting vendor accountability,
- ▶ Improving government services, and
- ▶ Fostering cross-agency collaboration and knowledge sharing.

A coalition across North America committed to responsible AI



As of April 23, 2024

- ▶ Over 250 public agencies
- ▶ Over 600 government practitioners
- ▶ 16 Mayors
- ▶ 11 City Managers
- ▶ 150 Directors, CIOs & CISO
- ▶ 150 Cities Adopted Open Letter
- ▶ 40 Non-profits/NGOs
- ▶ 30 Registered AI Vendors (8 with AI FactSheets)

Some quick observations

- ▶ There are a **lot** of ways to be involved, so bring others from your agency (and beyond)
- ▶ No, your agency isn't behind, everyone is in this together
- ▶ Folks want more training and more exposure to responsible AI applications

- ▶ Phase II - Implement (~12 months)
- ▶ Phase III - Address new challenges

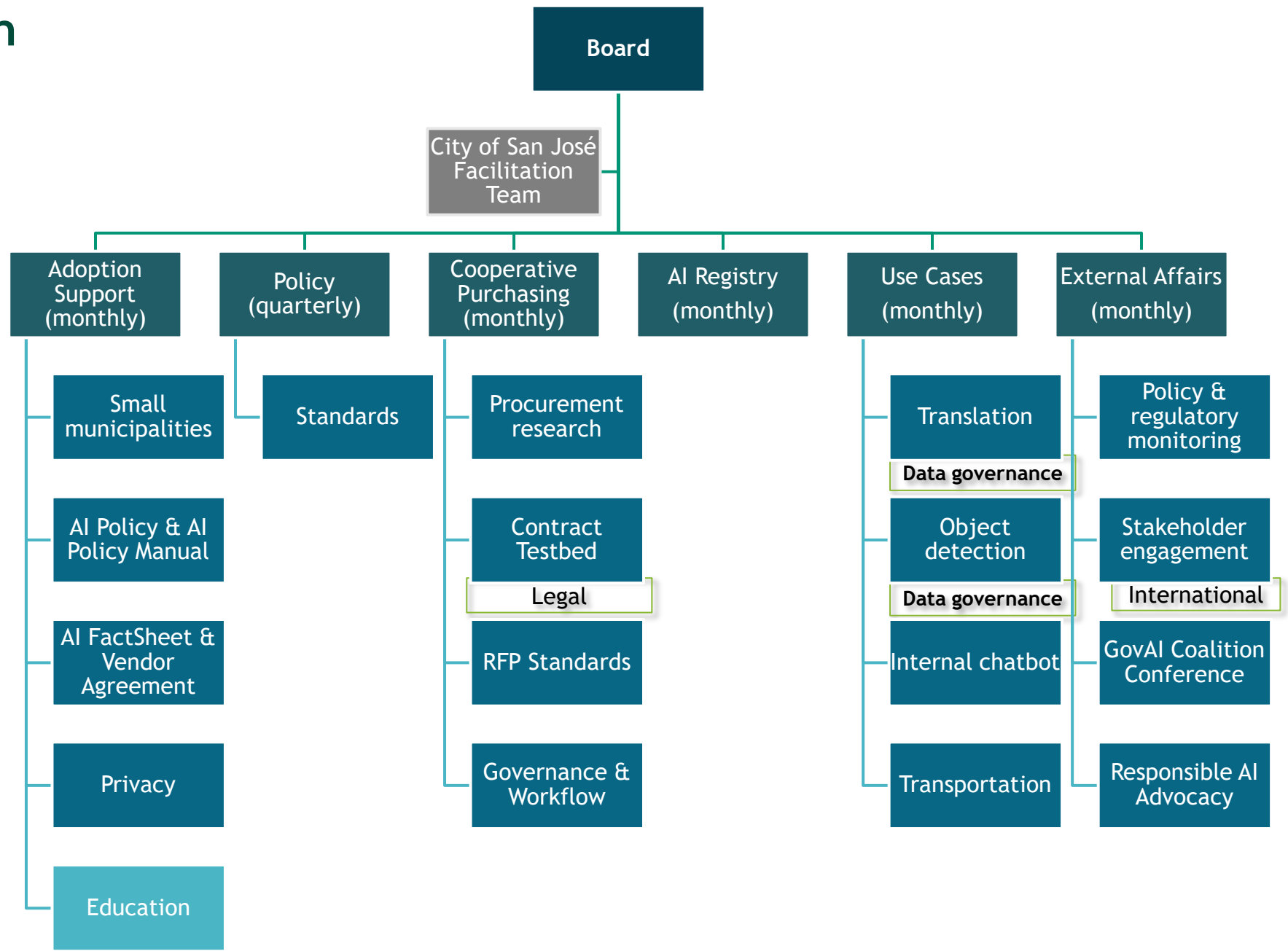

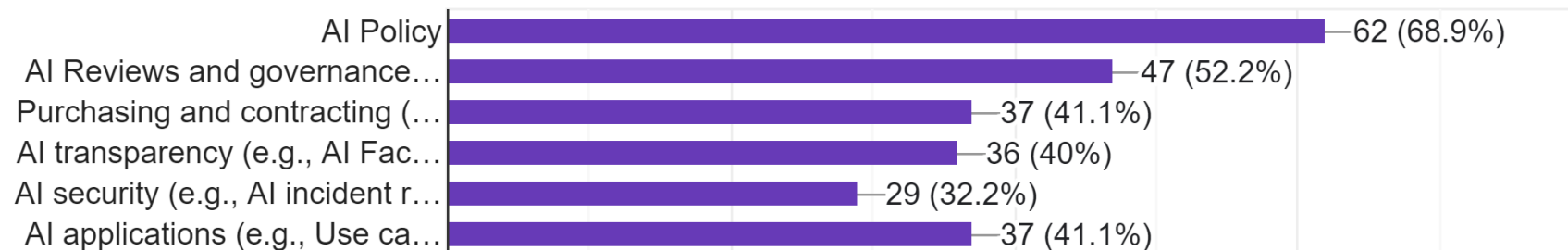

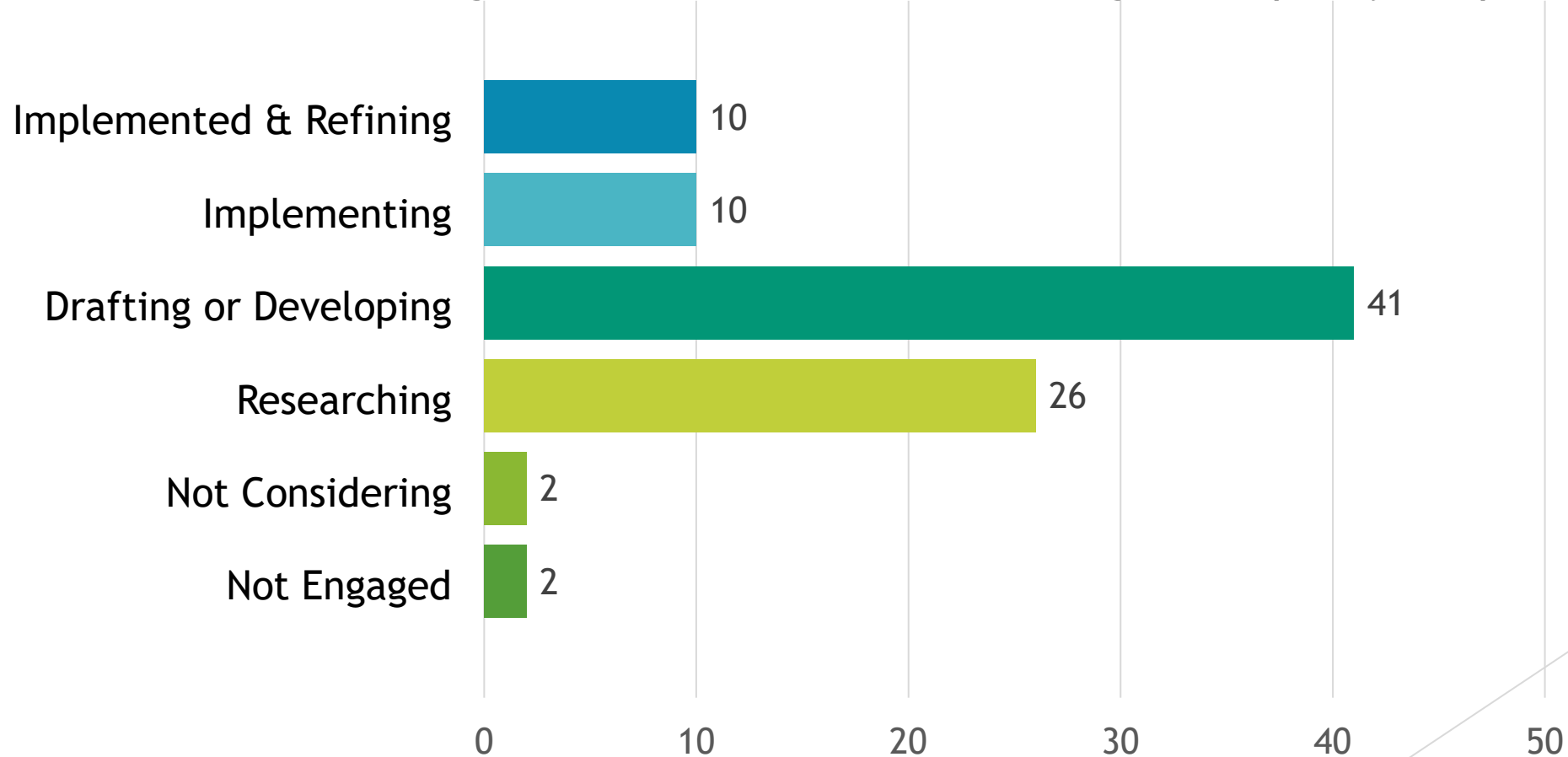


~90 agencies have adopted or are adopting GovAI Coalition materials in their agency

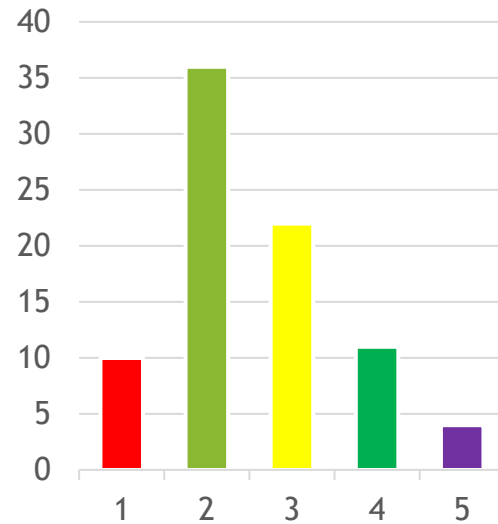

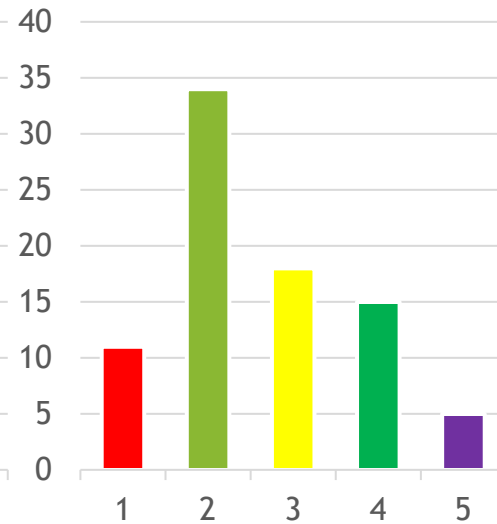

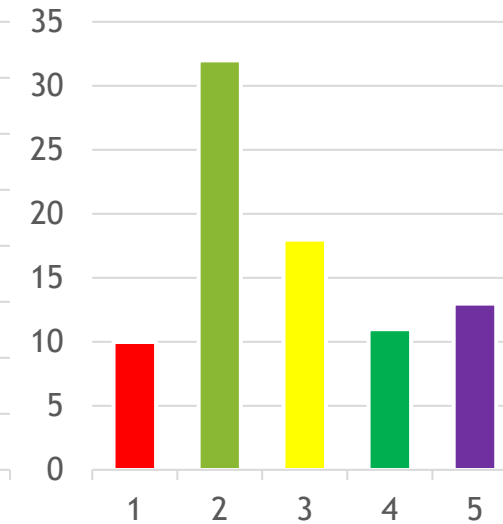
