The Saratoga Urban Village Plan Historic Resources Survey is part of the preparation of the Saratoga Urban Village Plan. This plan will be a consolidation of the Saratoga Avenue and the Paseo de Saratoga Urban Villages.

What is a historic resource survey?

A planning tool for identifying, recording, and evaluating older buildings and places that help to tell the story of an event or important person, community or group, or have distinct architectural character.

What is the project goal?

The goal of the project is to identify older buildings and places in the Saratoga Urban Village Plan area and to document their history from the community's perspective. This will inform the preparation of the urban village plan and will help decision-makers consider the protection of properties that are significant to the community and provide a distinct sense of place.
