As of now, there have not been any measures introduced by the Mayor and Council through legislative action which are set to appear on the November Ballot. However, the Mayor's March Budget Message included the following direction to explore a potential measure:

"The City Manager is directed to explore placing a measure on the upcoming November 2024 ballot that would allow the city to enter long-term retail and commercial leases on city park land and direct the resulting revenues back into our parks, returning to Council no later than the end of May 2024 with a status update and any polling results."

The City Council has not taken follow up action on such a measure yet.
