NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (EIR) AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD (SCH# 2023080670)

A Draft Environmental Impact Report (Draft EIR) for the 380 North First Street Residential Project is now available for public review and comment. The project includes a Site Development Permit to allow the demolition of an existing 12,000-square-foot Candidate City Landmark building and the removal of 20 trees (including 10 ordinance-size trees) for the construction of a seven-story, 118-unit multifamily residential building, subject to the State Density Bonus Law, including 18 units affordable to very-low-income, low-income, and moderate-income households and 74 parking spaces, on an approximately 0.48-gross acre lot.

Location: The project site is located at 380 North 1st Street on the north side of Basset Street between North 1st Street and North 2nd Street in San José.

The proposed project will have potentially significant environmental effects with regard to air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, and noise and vibration. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires this notice to disclose whether any listed toxic sites are present at the project location. The project location is not contained on a list of hazardous materials sites maintained by the State in accordance with California Public Resources Code Section 65962.5.

Written comments must be received at the Planning Department by 5:00 p.m. on December 2, 2024, in order to be addressed as part of the formal EIR review process.
