BACKGROUND

Gasoline service stations have traditionally provided the public a number of related services with air, water, window washing equipment and restrooms being the most common. However, there has been a recent trend by self-service stations in particular to provide fewer services. The City Council, concerned about the reduction of such services, adopted a policy to insure their provision.

PURPOSE

To establish Council Policy setting related service requirements for the issuance of use permits or development permits for all gasoline service stations. The policy is intended to prevent inconvenience and hardship to the consuming public.

POLICY

It is the policy of the City Council that all gasoline service stations, which are henceforth granted use permits or development permits, provide and maintain compressed air, water, car window washing equipment and men's and women's restrooms for the welfare and convenience of the consuming public.
