(d) Recap of FY 2011-12 (L. Corsiglia, Housing Department)

Staff provided a report on the key events and issues affecting housing in FY 2011-12. These include: dissolution of RDA, lack of resources due to the elimination of RDA and diminishing State and federal funds, increasing rents and improving for-sale market likely to lead to even worse affordability problems than before, overcrowding and associated safety hazards, and homelessness.

Commission discussion followed the staff report.

(e) Department Priorities for FY 2012-13 Housing Department (L. Corsiglia, Housing)

Staff provided a report on the Housing Department's policy priorities for FY 2012-13. They include: exploring new revenue sources, policies, and incentives for housing; working on Redevelopment Law; continuing to work on the City's inclusionary ordinance; facilitating pipeline projects; implementing urban villages; furthering the place-based strategy; addressing homelessness; facilitating fair housing efforts; and working on regional issues with neighboring cities.

Commission discussion followed the staff report.

(f) Priorities and Issues Facing San José in 2012-13 (Vice Mayor Nguyen, District 7)

The Vice Mayor discussed her top priorities for housing in FY 2012-13, including Title 20 changes to increase the distance between schools and incompatible land uses, burglaries, and homelessness.

Commission discussion followed the report.

(g) Commissioner Statements and Priorities (W. Chen, Housing Department)

Commissioners presented their top housing priorities for FY 2012-13.

Chair Darrow: fill the RDA void; partner with cities and county; implement the General Plan; educate and frame housing issues; and focus on housing for extremely low-income residents.

Vice Chair Tom: interested in Housing 1000; create housing for those greatest in need, emphasis on extremely low-income housing; and create opportunities for people to be able to live and work in the San Jose

Commissioner Ellak: implement urban villages; communicate the value of the Housing Department; create housing opportunities for extremely low-income, middle class, and senior households; work with developers; and find ways to lower the cost of development

Commissioner Norimoto: explore the potential for the Commission provide education to others on underlying housing issues; explore out of the box thinking in a post-RDA world.

Commissioner Pandey: address the homelessness issue, especially on increasing services; focus on extremely low-income housing; and work with private companies to develop funding sources for urban villages and energy efficiency.

(h) Review of 2011-12 Accomplishments of Housing and Community (W. Chen, Housing)

Staff provided a report of the Housing Commission's accomplishments, agenda items heard, and motions made.

(i) Brainstorming, Development, and Possible Approval of 2012-13 HCDC Workplan (W. Chen, Housing)
