
## SANTA CLARA COUNTY

2013 Homeless Census & Survey Every two years in January, communities across the country conduct comprehensive counts of their homeless population to gain a better understanding of the individuals who are currently experiencing homelessness, and to apply for federal funding for homeless programs.

The 2013 Santa Clara County Point-in-Time Count was a community-wide effort conducted on January 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013. In the weeks following the street count, a survey was administered to 856 unsheltered and sheltered homeless individuals, in order to profile their experience and characteristics.

















## What is a disabling condition?

A disabling condition is defined here as a physical disability, mental illness, chronic depression, alcohol or drug abuse, chronic health problems, HIV/AIDS, Post-traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), or a developmental disability.


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














### Summary
