



Scheduling Process — step 1

- Mandatory are prescheduled:
 - Caucus process in Nov; Budget in spring (varies w/ Mayor's preferences); Work Plan at end of term (with WP "topic" discussion prior month). Actual Caucuses are off-calendar
- Body Cam presentation by SJPD: they want Nov.
- We want to determine our internal work processes early so that we can employ them: discuss in Sept., finalize by Oct.
- County's Homeless task force will finish by Nov/Dec: we should report out prior. Have 2 sessions:
 - Start: set up subcmte and set expectations in Sept
 - Report: discuss findings & approve a report to Council Oct.

Scheduling Process — step 2

- Fireworks: lots of community & Cmsn interest.
 - start subcmte in Nov (& request status report from City: spur City to prep for New Years Eve)
 - discuss subcmte findings in Apr & NC report out in May, to impact City in timely fashion for July 4th
- Auditor:
 - gives annual report on Service Efficiency in Feb.
 - follow-up w/ Auditor in Apr (aid w/ Budget discussion?)
- Don't want to do everything at once, so:
 - start Gang & Crime subcmte in Nov, finish report in Jan.
 - Community Input: start in Jan, finish & report out in Feb.
 - start Illegal Dump in Jan, discuss in Feb, report out Mar.

Scheduling Process – step 3

- Chair received add'l requests for agendizing:
 - Refresher on Brown Act. Staff agrees it's a good idea:
 Sept. (w/ NC discussion as to whether more is wanted)
 - Suggestion that NC should host Special Session(s) to publicly discuss selection criteria for new SJ Police Chief.
 - NC did host such session(s) last cycle
 - Timing: discuss at Oct. NC mtg. whether & how to be involved
- June mtg: leave room for any unfinished business.
- The following chart shows the proposed schedule, color-coded by category, <u>BOLD</u> for "mandatory", ">" for optional.
 - Don't have to do all categories; not doing "transportation"
